Raging Waters FAQ

Q. When is Raging Waters Park Day?

A. Raging Waters Park day will be held on May 15th, 2020

Q. Is the Park open to the General Public?

A. : No, Raging Waters **will not** be open to the public on our celebration day on May 15th, 2020. This is a **PRIVATE EVENT** and only the participating schools are invited.

Q. What time will students be leaving and returning home?

A. Students should arrive at Travis Ranch and head to the gymnasium by 7:45 am. We are planning to arrive at TRMS around 4:00pm.

- Because of traffic, this may change. If this occurs, students will be able to contact you via cell phone to give you an update.

Q. What happens if my student misses the bus?

A. If you miss the bus you will not be able to attend the event.

Q. Will my student have to make up missed schoolwork?

A. No, your student will be excused from schoolwork given on May 15th, 2020. Any work that would have been due on May 15th, must be turned in by Monday May 18th.

Q. What should students bring on Friday?

A. Students will need to be dressed for Raging Waters with appropriate clothing over their bathing suits. T-shirts may be worn in the park, but not on all the rides because they may stick to the water slides and can cause injury. Rash guards are permitted on rides.

- TRMS dress code will be expected (except for flip flops, which may be worn).
- All swimsuits must be in good taste and modestly cover the body.
- Please do not bring valuables. TRMS and Raging Waters are not responsible for any damaged, lost or stolen items.
- In a small bag, bring water in a plastic bottle, sunscreen, dry clothes, a towel and money for lunch/snacks as outside food may not be brought into the park. Please do not send more than \$20 cash with your student.
- Parents, please put waterproof sunscreen on your child before school and send it with your child to reapply during the day.

Q. Are there Lockers Available?

A. Yes. One-time use lockers are available at 4 locations in the park. They range from \$12-\$20 depending on size. Students can share lockers but should only do so with someone they trust. You can also leave your belongings at the TR cabanas.

Q. Will there be Lifeguards present on May 15th, 2020?

A. Yes, Lifeguards and a first aid station are provided at the park. Life vests are available at no charge.

Q. Will students have to “check-in” throughout the day on May 15th, 2020

A. Yes, there will be **Mandatory check in!**

- TR Staff and parent chaperones will be in a cabana marked Travis Ranch Middle School.
- Mandatory check in for ALL students will be at the cabana between 11:00-11:30 a.m. This is a good time to reapply sunscreen.

Q. Will lunch be provided to my students?

A. Student may request for a school lunch to be provided to them on May 15th, 2020. Lunch forms will be sent home closer to the day of the event.

The park does not allow outside food or drinks besides plastic water bottles. Should your child bring a sack lunch, they may eat at a designated picnic area located outside of the park. They should let a chaperone know so they can be supervised. There are meal options that can be purchased at the park for approximately \$10-15.

Q. Will there be a field trip permission slip?

A. Yes, we will be sending home field trip permission slips to all eligible students closer to the event.

Q. My student reached the Platinum – Raging Waters Level, but does not want to go?

A. If your student does not wish to attend the Raging Waters day on May 15th, 2020 you'll write “Not going” on the field trip form that will be sent out closer to the date. Students not participating in the Raging Waters field trip are expected to attend their regularly scheduled classes.

Q. What are the Water Park Rules?

A. Raging Waters Park Rules:

- All regular school rules apply as you represent Travis Ranch School and it is a school day.
- No profanity, vandalism, line jumping or saving places for others in ride lines.
- Students must wear proper swimming attire that is modest and in good condition. Nylon type swimwear is recommended for all water attractions, and rash guards are allowed.
- No denim, cut offs, long pants, or basketball shorts are allowed on water rides. No swimsuits with extreme forms of ornamentation (buckles, belts, etc.) are allowed.
- T-shirts/rash guards may be worn over proper swim attire only. T-shirts cannot be worn on many of the rides. Please consult with the ride attendant at each ride for more information.
- Some of the water slides have height requirements, so please check the safety information before getting on the ride.
- Lifeguards are stationed throughout the park. Students should give prompt respect to instructions given by guards and ride attendants.
- Do not jump or dive into any attraction.
- Obey all safety signs, listen to all instructions by lifeguards, ride attendants, and walk at all times. Anyone not respecting these rules may be sent to security, and the school will be responsible for further disciplinary actions.
